Apprentice Identification Card

You can download your new Apprentice ID Card by following these steps:

- 1) Log into your MyTradesecrets (MTS) account
- 2) Confirm your MTS profile is up-to-date.
- 3) Select the "Applications" tab.
- 4) Click the "Details" button at the end of your current application.
- 5) Under "Program Summary", click the "Print a new apprentice ID card" button.

You can then download and print, or email, your new Apprentice ID Card.

It is important to have your Apprentice ID card with you on the jobsite. An employer may ask for your Apprentice ID Card Show to see where you are at in your apprenticeship program. When you complete a period, show your updated Apprentice ID Card to your employer to confirm progression, and move to your next pay increase.
